Five 30 cubic yard dumpsters will be available at 17935 Canterbury drive (end of driveway) from 8 am to 5:00 pm. We will continue into Sunday if there are still empty dumpsters and will update the website Saturday evening with that information.

Some volunteer help may be available trailering items from your truck or trailer to the dumpsters. Please email board@canterbury-hoa.com with your request for help. We will also have support at the dumpster site for heavy or awkward items.

**** ON ARRIVAL, CHECK-IN WITH THE VOLUNTEER AT THE END OF DRIVEWAY ****

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS that are allowed in the dumpster

- **Yard Waste**
Yard waste, organic materials (plant materials such as grass, flowers, leaves, weeds, garden plants, landscape and pruning waste, food and food scraps such as fruit, vegetables, meat, bones, shells, dairy and leftovers and food-soiled paper such as paper towels, napkins and delivery pizza boxes, stumps less than 3 feet in diameter, bagged pine needles, and tree branches in one-foot lengths.
- **Appliances**
Note any appliances with freon (such as refrigerators) are PROHIBITED.
- **Upholstered Furniture and mattresses**
- **Household Trash**
- **Garbage and household items**

PROHIBITED ITEMS that are NOT allowed in the dumpster

- **Electronics**

- Medical Waste
- Household Chemicals
- Waste Oils
- Oil Filters and Containers
- Hazardous Waste Materials
- Automobile Parts and Batteries
- Wet Cement
- Household Plant Fertilizers
- Propane Tanks
- Paints (**unless can is empty, they are prohibited**)
- Industrial Waste
- Septic Tanks
- Liquid Sludge
- Gasoline Cans and Tanks
- Asbestos
- Chemicals/ FREON
- Full Sand Bags
- Tires (NO TIRES ARE PERMITTED. THERE WILL BE A \$25 FEE PER TIRE FOUND IN DUMPSTER)
- Fire Extinguishers
- Televisions
- Florescent bulbs

If you are unsure of the item(s) you plan to dispose of, please contact the board or ask the volunteer at the site to determine if the item is acceptable to throw into the roll off.
